Description

Alfred Mauritz Bergstrom (1869-1930) Swedish School

Alfred Bergstrom studied initially at the Stockholm Academy of Fine Art; he then furthered his artistic education in Frankfurt, Germany in 1894 and 1895. Bergstrom travelled widely in France, where he found a great affinity with the impressionist style of painting, and despite being a long term resident of Stockholm his work consists almost entirely of sweeping landscapes of France of Sweden. In 1910 Bergstrom was appointed a professor to the Royal Swedish Academy where he was also a member. His paintings were represented in the Swedish Exposition in Paris in 1929 and today his work is in the permanent collections of the museums of Gothenburg and Sweden.
